- (c) to promote acquisition of knowledge in a rapidly developing and changing society and to continually offer opportunities for upgrading knowledge, training and skills in the context of innovations, research and discovery in all fields of human endeavours;
- (d) to provide an innovative system of University level education, flexible and open, in regard to methods and pace of learning, combination of courses, eligibility for enrolment, age of entry, medium of instruction, conduct of examination and operation of the programmes with a view to promoting learning and encouraging excellence in new fields of knowledge;
- (e) to contribute to the improvement of the educational system in the State by providing a non-formal channel complementary to the formal system and encouraging transfer of credits and exchange of teaching staff by making wide use of texts and other software developed by the University;
- (f) to provide education and training in the various arts, crafts and skills of the country, raising their quality and improving their availability to the people;
- (g) to provide or arrange for training of teachers required for such activities or institutions;
- (h) to provide suitable post-graduate courses of study and promote research;
- (i) to provide counselling and guidance to its students; and
- (j) to promote national integration and the integrated development of the human personality through its policies and programmes;
- (k) to encourage the Open University and distance education systems in the educational pattern of the State and to coordinate and determine the standard in such systems.

Core Values

- (i). **Cost Effective:** TNOU is the only University in the State to offer its Academic Programmes and render the services at affordable cost.

(ii). Life Long Learning (LLL): The System of University fosters an environment that promotes a lifelong learning for its constituents and uses feedback from learners, peer groups, employers. TNOU has a heterogeneous group of learners with the range of age of 18-85 Years.

(iii). Integrity: The System of University conducts its operations and makes its public representations in an ethical manner. It assesses its operations in an open and collaborative manner and practices fairness, honesty, and objectivity in dealing with its constituencies.

(iv). Quality: The System of University holds a strong commitment to meet the bench mark determined by the regulators in all aspects of its learning activities, learning outcomes, and support services including the extension programmes. It seeks to continuously strengthen the overall effectiveness of its operations.

(v). Access: The System of University seeks to broaden access to its higher education programmes by all the segment of the society who wish to engage the organization in their learning goals.

(vi). Equity: The System of University treats all the stakeholders equally without any discrimination.

(vii). Collaboration: TNOU collaborates with recognized educational institutions, industries and organisations to provide access, skills, employability and capacity building among learners and thereby to achieve excellence in the University operations.

(viii). Accountability: The University is accountable to its constituencies and the public for fulfilling its mission in an appropriate manner by openly assessing its operations and by inviting external evaluations by public agencies.

About the University

TNOU was established in 2002 by the Act (No.27 of 2002) of Tamil Nadu Legislature Assembly, with the objective of introducing and promoting Open Distance Learning (ODL) for the higher education needs of unreached population. TNOU has obtained UGC 2(f) in 2005 and one among the five State Open Universities in the Country, to have been accorded with 12(B) Status under Sec.12(B) of the UGC, New Delhi in January 2016.

TNOU is the 10th State Open University in India. 16 State Open Universities and one National Open University (i.e. IGNOU) offer Academic Programmes using Open and Distance Mode in India.

The TNOU started functioning at rented building in Directorate of Technical Education Campus from 06-02-2003. In 2011, the TNOU Administrative Building was inaugurated, in 2015 the TNOU Academic Block and Material Production and Distribution Block were inaugurated and in 2020 the additional Floors in the Academic Block and Material Production and Distribution Block at Headquarters and TNOU Regional Centre and Constituent Community College at Villupuram were inaugurated.

TNOU operates through three tier system, i.e. (1) Headquarters (HQ), (2) Regional Centres (RCs) and (3) Learner Support Centres (LSCs). The TNOU Headquarters is located in Saidapet, Chennai, the Regional Centres and Constituent Community Colleges were established at prime locations of the State, viz. (1) Chennai, (2) Coimbatore, (3) Dharmapuri, (4) Madurai, (5) Mayiladuthurai, (6) Nilgiris, (7) Salem, (8) Sivagangai, (9) Trichy, (10) Villupuram, (11) Tirunelveli, (12) Tiruvannamalai and the LSCs are located in all the districts of Tamil Nadu in the affiliated Arts and Science Colleges (both Government and Private) to cater to the needs of learner society from all walks of life.

The motto of TNOU- **“EDUCATION FOR ALL AND EVER”**, promises to reach out to those unreached - to all those higher education aspirants. Like other Open Universities in India, the TNOU was established in pursuance of National Policy on Education, (NPE)-1986 on the recommendation of Central Education Advisory Board (CEAB), Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India.

The Women, Office goers, Working professionals, Housewives, the Disadvantaged groups of the society and people from hill and backward regions, who cannot pursue education through face to face conventional mode get an opportunities to learn through Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode.



Academic Building of TNOU

As the Tamil Nadu State boasts as one of the highest Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in the Country at 52 % (for 2019-20, AISHE), the role of TNOU is vital in enhancing the GER of the Tamil Nadu State to the highest level. The TNOU has established and created an excellent Academic and Administrative infrastructure facilities at its Headquarters in Chennai and its 12 Regional Centers across Tamil Nadu.

TNOU is headed by Honorable Governor of Tamil Nadu, who is the Chancellor, and the Minister for Higher Education of Tamil Nadu is the Pro-Chancellor. The Vice Chancellor of TNOU is the Academic and Administrative Head of the University. The TNOU comprises the Chancellor, Pro Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor, Syndicate, Planning Board, Academic Council, Finance Committee and Boards of Studies. Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Finance Officer, and Controller of Examinations are Statutory Officers of the University.

TNOU contribution for the Open and Distance Learning system is more valuable. In the entire State of Tamil Nadu, the TNOU has established 12 Regional Centres and 3 Constituent Community Colleges. In addition, the TNOU has approved 143 affiliated Colleges as Learner Support Centres (LSC) and 124 Community Colleges across the State. The Significant role of TNOU is in enhancing the GER of the State of Tamil Nadu. In terms of providing quality and relevant education, the role of TNOU is highly commendable particularly, the Academic Programmes, Courses, Curriculum, quality Self-Learning Materials (SLM), Academic Counselling Classes, Testing Method, Transparency in the conduct of Term End Examinations, Evaluation and announcement of results.

BA, BBA, MBA, M.Sc, M. Com, MA, B.Sc. and B.Ed. Special Education Programmes are some of the most sought-after Programmes among others. Admission to TNOU Programmes is done twice in a year in the months of January and July as per the UGC-DEB guidelines, and all the admissions are done only online. Access to E-content, eSLMs, Books and journals in the main library, recorded video lectures are additional advantages to TNOU students.

TNOU has well known support services for its students - establishment of Student Support Services Division, Entrepreneurship cum Skill Development Centre, Community Colleges for offering Vocational Programmes, Campus Recruitment drives, online and off-line counselling. On-line admission and digital payments of all kinds for fee payment are some recent initiatives of the TNOU. Skill development programmes and continuous counselling sessions during Saturdays and Sundays are other student support services

provided to TNOU learners. With the help of the academic infrastructure and facilities, the online and off-line student support over social media are provided to the TNOU learners.


The meeting of IAAA committee was planned on 06.01.2023. The IAAA committee was assisted by the CIQA Director and members for conducting the academic and administrative audit.

The Committee had a formal meeting with the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Faculty Chairpersons, Controller of Examinations, Director (Research), Heads of Divisions / Departments / Centres / Cells and the Programme Coordinators during which the Director CIQA presented the overview, developments and the achievements of TNOU. Members of the Committee were briefed about the objectives of the academic and administrative audit and the procedure involved. The members visited the Schools / Departments / Centres / Sections / Cells on 11.01.2023 and 12.01.2023 to inspect the infrastructural facilities in the schools / departments such as classrooms, laboratories and interacted with the teaching staff and the technical staff to know the academic and administrative performance.



Further, the Committee after completing various stages of inspection and interactions prepared the IAAA report for TNOU covering the summarized observations and recommendations.






The marks obtained are 772 out of 1000 (77.20%)

Observation of IAAA Committee:

1. Observed that the various Curricular Aspects and Examination, Evaluation activities are progressing periodically in various Schools and Departments of the University. The Boards of Studies (BOS) of various Schools of Study should take more care designing and developing the curriculum. Further proper care should be taken by the concerned BOS for maintaining overall quality and design the syllabus as per the industries expectations. More emphasis should be laid on introduction of new Skill based courses.
2. TNOU may take note of the fact that the enrolment in some of the academic programmes is low. It is observed that the TNOU may take appropriate steps to increase the enrolment in those academic programmes by giving more thrust to those Schools and Departments.
3. The University may make provision for involvement of industry representatives in Boards of Studies and Curricular development activities which in turn will help to develop and introduce skill-based Curriculum.
4. It is noticed that a few Schools and departments have failed to maintain the student's feedback reports. The Committee recommends to the University to insist the department concerned to collect the feedback regularly and submit to CIQA for analysis.
5. Separate mechanism to be developed for disseminating the outcome of the student's feedback analysis to the department concerned for further improvement.

6. The Faculty Members in each department needs be motivated and encouraged to actively take part in the research and publications. They should be encouraged properly to involve in consultancy and collaboration with the industry.
7. The Placement Cell needs to be more vibrant.
8. It is recommended to the University for Regular Maintenance of the administrative buildings with structured mechanism.
9. It is noticed that a few departments have failed to follow the academic calendar. The University may take note of it to bring the parity among other programmes.
10. Proper Communication flow must be ensured among different divisions of the University including Regional Centres and Learner Support Centres.
