Introduction:

The Online workshop on “**e-Content Development using OER and ICT**” organized by School of Journalism and New Media Studies, Tamil Nadu Open University (TNOU) in collaboration with Commonwealth Educational Media Centre for Asia (CEMCA), New Delhi was conducted on 4thMay to 6thMay 2020.

The workshop aimed to train the Academic Staffs and Technical Staffs of TNOU on Search for OER in their subject area like on OER commons, Create concept maps digitally, Develop e-content-Video using free software available, Create online quiz for online assessment by the Open Universities. The resource person of the workshop was Dr. Nisha Singh, Deputy Director, Centre for Online Learning, IGNOU.

This workshop is the second phase of training programme conducted by SOJNMS, the first workshop was conducted on 18-21 Nov 2019 exclusively on development of OER content for the faculties of TNOU.

Day 1:

The workshop began with the inaugural session on 4th May 2020 at 10.30am at EMPRC with the welcome address by Dr. P. Chitra, Director i/c, School of Journalism and New Media Studies followed by keynote address by Prof. Madhu Parhar, Director, CEMCA in which Prof. Madhu Parhar insisted on the need of the workshop and the future assignments with TNOU and the inaugural address was delivered by Prof. K. Parthasarathy, Vice-Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Open University said that the workshop serves the need of the hour for updating the teaching – learning skill by the Academic and Technical staff members of TNOU. Dr. P. Thiyagarajan, Registrar, TNOU delivered the felicitation address, Dr. Manas Ranjan Panigrahi, Senior Programme officer (Education), CEMCA coordinated the workshop through online platform. There were 45 participants in the workshop includes the Teaching staffs and Technical Staffs of TNOU who were present at their residence and connected through virtual platform.

The first day session from 10.45 – 12 Noon by Dr. Nisha Singh dealt with OER licensing and need for OER repository in Open Universities, she also taught the C-map tool, a product that empowers users to construct, navigate, share and criticize knowledge models represented as concept maps. This can be utilized in work, studies, or research. The resource person assigned the participants to prepare a structure using c-map tool and she had the asynchronous interaction with the participants through WhatsApp and other virtual sources.

Day 2: 5th May 2020

Dr. Nisha Singh the resource person of the workshop reviewed the work submitted by the participants with her comments and suggestions. The second day session dealt with video capturing tools such as screencastify, screen castomatic, freecam, presentation tube etc.

They are the tools which help for capturing video from the screen and the audio can also be recorded during the capturing. Hence these tools can be used for creation of video with narration of the instructor. The resource person instructed the participants to prepare a video using any one of the tools and submit through the WhatsApp group. The asynchronous session was done from 2-4 pm

Day 3-6th May 2020:

The final day of the workshop dealt with evaluation tools available as open resources. The tools taught on the day were Quizz, Hot potatoes and Kahoot. They are generally for creation of online quiz and help the instructor to evaluate the learners on the understanding level of the session handled by them. There were many methods in quizzes they are dealt in detail by the resource person and there was interaction between the participants and resource person.

The workshop ended with the concluding note from Dr. Madhu Parhar, Director, CEMCA and vote of thanks by Dr. P. Chitra
